**HUNGER FIGHT packs over ONE MILLION MEALS  
In Salt Lake City, UT**

Jacksonville, FL — HUNGER FIGHT, Inc. announced today that it recently worked with sponsors and volunteers in Salt Lake City to pack over one million meals to help those at risk for hunger. The event, a multi-organization partnership among local organizations, foundations and faith partners, was held during the Silicon Slopes Tech Summit.

Six thousand (6,000) plus volunteers, working a minimum of two hours shifts over the course of two days, packed 1,058,400 meals. All of the meals were donated to the Utah Food Bank and will help feed children and families in the Greater Utah community.
