FACTS

OUR RESPONSE

- Hunger Fight, in collaboration with schools, administrators and community partners, continued feeding children in our Feed the Backpack program during shutdowns. We also distributed additional meals in direct response to the COVID19 pandemic and continue to meet the needs of our community.
- Over 2500 children in 47 zip codes are currently enrolled in our Feed the Need to Read literacy program

COVID-19: Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Hunger Fight has and continues to provide weekend meals to children and their families. Our partnerships with community and feeding programs, faith partners and volunteers enable us to respond quickly to the needs of our community. Since March, additional meals have been distributed.
